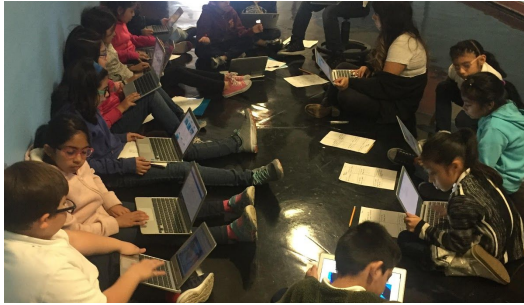

Hello Patrick Henry Families! We are at the end of our first Quarter already and we are excited to see all of the great learning that is happening around our school.

As we continue building our personalized learning environments in each of our classrooms, we have been identifying the specific learning paths for each of our students. Grades PreK-1st have completed their TRC testing and are using writing instruction to build our students reading and comprehension skills. Grades 2-4 have created learner profiles and began their units using voice and choice where students are learning based on their interests. Grades 5-6 are working within their projects and personalized learning time within Summit Learning. Each student in 5th and 6th grade is paired up with a teacher or staff member to mentor them on a weekly basis.
