Math Assignments

Success Criteria: Each day you will work on completing your math review packet. You will also complete one page in your blue math booklet. I will also be teaching a math lesson on google classroom from your GO MATH book for Chapter 8 or Chapter 9. I will be uploading videos for you to watch and follow along in your go math on google classroom. I will also post videos of new math lessons that are not in your go math book and that will just be done in our math journals. I will post quizzes too. If you can, please also complete **at least** 10 lessons on dreambox each week.

Reading Assignments

Success Criteria: Each day you will read **two chapters** of **The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane** and answer the questions for each chapter in your two reading packets. I will also be uploading videos of each chapter on google classroom if you want to listen and follow along with your book. Some of the questions will also be available to answer and submit on google classroom. I will also be assigning discussion questions to answer on Google Classroom and on FlipGrid.

Science Assignments

Success Criteria: You must complete at least 3 projects each week. You will go to the following website www.brainson.org on your phone/tablet/computer. You will select a podcast to listen to and you will take notes in your journal or on google classroom on any facts you learned, questions you had about the topic, connections you made, and anything you found interesting! Then, with your notes, you will choose one of the following project options:

- Share what you learned with a family member and write down what they think/said about the topic
- Create a poster about the things you learned
- Create a FlipGrid about what you learned
- Create a quiz with answers for your classmates
- Create a comic strip for the podcast
- Pretend you're a critic and write a review of the podcast
- Create an advertisement for the episode
- Create your OWN project

For all of these activities you can submit them on google classroom by either writing in a google document, taking a picture and submitting it to me on a google document or you can share/email it to me at iluna9@cps.edu or wait to turn them in when we come back. There is also a FlipGrid app that you can download on your phone or tablet if you do not have access to a computer.

Social Studies Assignments

Success Criteria: You must complete at least 3 responses each week on www.newsela.com I will be assigning a Newsela Article. You will read and answer the questions. You will also be submitting a response to a question related to the article that I will post on google classroom and on FlipGrid. You have the option to respond on google classroom or on FlipGrid. You can access everything on google classroom. There is also a Newsela App you can download on your phone or tablet where you can read the articles **offline** and answer the questions without using the internet in your journal.

Writing Assignments

Success Criteria: Each day, you will choose one prompt to write about in your notebook or you can create your own! Each writing piece must be at least 2-3 paragraphs long. You can choose to type it and submit on google classroom or you can write it in your journal and submit when we come back. Please make sure that you are checking your spelling and are writing neatly.
